

BLUE GRASS SPORTSMEN'S LEAGUE
Alternative Vehicle Use Policy

Alternative Vehicles, including ATVs, UTVs and Golf Carts, may be used by BGS� members, guests and NON-BGS� members participating in BOD approved events on BGS� property under the following conditions-

- Operators must have a valid state issued driver's license.
- Operators of Alternative Vehicles must yield right of way to conventional vehicles.
- Operators of Alternative Vehicles must follow posted speed limits.
- All Alternative Vehicles used during the hours of darkness must have permanently installed lights that are operating.

Operators must drive only on maintained roads and cart paths except-

- For approved Division use including but not limited to; Gun Dog Division for placing birds, Trap and Skeet/Sporting Clays Divisions for setting traps and transporting targets, Archery for setting target and by League employees in normal course of club business
- By Hunters to transport equipment and harvested game
- By those possessing a valid handicapped parking permit to access the lake or approved hunting areas.

No other off road driving will be permitted unless approved in advance by the Operations Manager.

Actions that are not environmentally sensitive are not acceptable. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the immediate suspension of the use of an Alternative Vehicles. The member shall then be subject to a review hearing before the BGS� board before permission to use an Alternative Vehicles is re-instated.
