In March BGSL had \$177,211 total in all accounts Dupree account has \$132,000

The Tractor was purchased from the main account. Entered under equipment as an asset, and will show in the depreciation line

Income is down \$11,500 from budget mainly through division accounts, which partially was due to a Shotgun event last year. However division expenses are down \$10,000 from last year.

Net income shows a loss of \$13,000. Losses were related to 3 reasons

- 1) \$8000 was budgeted for timber, but that should show up in April deposit,
- 2) Corporate memberships did not renew,
- 3) Two payments were made to workers comp, how it was invoiced.

YTD showed \$5500 better than budgeted
