

## Gate Management Policy

- 1) Beginning December 1, 2008 the BGS� front gate will be closed at all times.
- 2) Members may access the property with a valid gate card, and they may bring in guests via the established Guest Policy.
- 3) Open Event hosts are responsible for providing gate management during Open Events (See Open Event Policy).
- 4) No tailgating. To keep members out of the position of having to check gate passes and membership status, there will be no tailgating – only one vehicle through the gate at a time.
- 5) Operations will post a sign on the gate clearly indicating that tailgating is not allowed, with instructions on what to do if a gate card does not work and how to gain access for a tour.
- 6) Arrangements must be made to meet construction equipment and delivery vehicles. The gate will not be left open and unattended.
- 7) In the event of a mechanical failure of the gate equipment, the gate may be left open to provide member access, however, non members are not allowed to come on to BGS� property for purposes other than touring the grounds without an invitation from a host. The “Closed Gate” policy does not change if the gate malfunctions.

This policy may be suspended or changed on a case by case basis by a simple majority vote by the BGS� Board.

### **Effective Date:**

December 1, 2008

An open event or open shoot implies that anyone (member or non-member) may use the division or facility without having a guest pass or BGS� member sponsor. ***There will be no fee for National or Regional open events. There will be a \$3.00 non-member charge for all other open events. The open event fee will accrue to the League.***

In order that members of BGS� receive maximum benefit of their League, the entrance gate will be closed at all times starting December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. Non-members may attend events and venues [***other than open events***] when they have a valid guest pass and are accompanied by a BGS� member.

There will be no open events scheduled Monday through Friday unless approved by the Board of Directors.
