



Minor Changes Due to Coronavirus

The outbreak of novel coronavirus here in the US and now in Kentucky has forced almost everyone to adapt to some extent. On March 19, the Board of Officers and Directors met to consider this issue. After hearing from President McCullar the results of consultations with legal and insurance authorities, the Board discussed the situation and voted to continue for now the existing policy of keeping the club open and allowing divisions to make individual decisions about events.

Additionally, it was decided to lock the front door of the clubhouse and post alternative contact information for office staff, in order to protect them from unnecessary contact during the outbreak. This policy will remain in effect until revoked by a vote of the Board.

Members are expected to follow safety guidelines from state and federal authorities, such as not gathering in groups and keeping a safe "social distance" from one another, as well as not coming if you are in an extremely high-risk group for infection or if you have known infection or reasonable evidence of exposure to the novel coronavirus. By staying open, the club intends to furnish its members with a safe, outdoor environment: Please take advantage of it in this way, but never forget to respect the safety of other members and staff with whom you may come into contact.

Finally, the virus outbreak has affected our ability to staff the GP Range without endangering the safety of RO's who are -- or have family-- in an at-risk group. As a result, GP Range hours are being reduced to approximately 7 hours a day for 7 days a week. The GP Range schedule for the period from March 21 through April 4 is published below:

Monday-Friday: 10AM-5PM

Saturdays & Sundays 9AM-5PM
