Treasurer Report: by Ron Summers

Total Cash All accounts \$257,103.56. The BSGL Main account is \$100,371.05. This includes \$56,000.00 of PPP money that was received April 27, 2020 through Central Bank, Nicholasville, KY. We must spend all of these funds to avoid the unspent balance becoming a 2 year SBA loan with a 1% interest rate. The spent funds can become a forgivable loan. The process to have the expended funds forgiven is still being worked out by SBA.

The Dupree account total value is \$178,252.57. This is up \$933.38 from March. Our bonds are performing very well considering the current economic situation.

Consolidated P & L shows a total Loss of \$42,426.24. This is \$37,026.20 more than the budget's projected loss. The Total Gross income is \$78,543.39 below the budgeted amount. This decreased income is offset by the \$39,384.43 reduction in expenses. The YTD earnings on our Dupree account of \$1,932.76 plus a small gain on the sale of an asset.

While the Main Club Income is down approximately \$8,500.00 the majority of lost income is in the divisions. Income for all divisions is down approximately \$70,000.00.

Total YTD Loss for all divisions is \$20,640.87, with the majority (\$19,630.01) being in Shotgun.

Total YTD Loss for Main Club (Main Club, Farm and GP Range) is \$21,785.76, with the majority (\$42,560.51) being in the GP Range.
