Total Cash All accounts \$ 275,591.28

Membership shows \$4,740.55 better than budget

The Dupree account total value is \$182,576.32

Total YTD Loss for Main Club (Main Club, Farm and GP Range) is \$24,612.55.

Total YTD Gain for all divisions is \$1,546.83.

Consolidated P & L for June shows a total Loss of \$23,145.72. This is an improvement over the YTD May loss of \$31,601.32.. The Total Gross income is \$44,157.84 below the budgeted amount. This decreased income is offset by a reduction in expenditures of \$28,555.61, the YTD earnings on our Dupree account of \$4,081.51 earned from September 2019.
