

2020 USPSA Area 5 Championship, September 11-13



When the original location in Ohio for the <u>USPSA Area 5</u> Championship cancelled the event due to coronavirus concerns there, the Pistol Division at the Blue Grass Sportsmen's League offered to host the match, and the USPSA accepted the offer. This is the highest level pistol match ever hosted at BGSL -- Area 5 includes Ilinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, Wisconsin, and West Virginia, so it is a huge honor for the Pistol Division and the Blue Grass Sportsmen's League and a recognition of excellent work here

in previous matches. Match Director Lafe Kunkel has already demonstrated his ability to organize complex matches and conduct them safely even with the additional considerations placed on him by the coronavirus situation earlier this year with the Kentucky USPSA All Divisions Championship Match in June, and the Pistol Division did it again with the Kentucky IDPA Championship in late July and early August with Aaron Brulc as Match Director.

As always, this match will require the support of BGSL members and their understanding during setup, match and take-down, particularly regarding Pit availability. Currently, **Pit 1** is scheduled to close for setup on Saturday, September 5 through the end of the match on the 13th and some period of tear-down afterwards. **Pits 3 & 4** will be closed from Monday, September 7, through the end of the match and some period of tear-down. **Pit 2** will close on Wednesday, September 9, and remain closed until the end of the match and for some time during tear-down. Remember to check the <u>BGSL Events Calendar</u> for the most up to date pit availability, as the calendar will be updated daily, particularly during take-down.
