#### Check Calendar for Rifle Range and Pit 4 Regularly

As we are able to staff and schedule additional RSOs to meet the requirements of the Temporary Range Use Policy for the 300 Yard Rifle Range and Pit 4, those ranges will be open to general members meeting the use requirements on a limited basis. At this time, the 300 Yard Rifle Range is open under the Temporary Range Use Policy on Thursdays and Saturdays. We will continue to publish the schedule for these uses one week at a time on the BGSL Website Events Calendar, so please get into the habit of checking the calendar regularly if you want to use these ranges and are properly certified. Meanwhile, GP is open as always, including the use of centerfires.

#### Safety Precautions During Hunting Season

During Hunting Season, remember to check the map of hunter check ins in the entry hall of the clubhouse before going any place other than the division main areas, ranges and pits. If a hunter is present in the area you intend to go, select another area. If the area of the map is clear, it is safe for you to proceed, but you should place a marker with your contact information and activity on the board and remove it before leaving the club.
