In general, BGSL offers primitive campsites, campsites with full RV hookups, and campsites with limited power and water. The permanent primitive campsites will be closed April 4-10 for the IBO setup and shoot, but alternative primitive camping locations will be available during this time. The grant application was successfully pursued by JCHS Trap and Skeet assistant coach Brandon Ironmonger.
