Introductory Carbine Skills Class, June 4

BGSL Training Certified Member Instructor Brian King is bringing back the hugely popular and often requested Carbine Skills classes, and this is the first of a series if you would like to participate.

This is a basic rifle class geared toward those who are new to the AR platform on **Saturday, June 4, 9am-1pm**. It will cover nomenclature and function of the main parts of the rifle, field stripping and basic maintenance, zeroing and confirming sights and/or optics at different distances, shooting from standing, kneeling, and prone positions, how to clear malfunctions, and more. Participants will need to bring their rifle and minimum of 100 rounds of ammunition, 2 magazines and a safe way to keep them on their person, and eye and ear protection. Long pants and a hat with a brim or bill are advised. Intermediate level classes will be coming soon, and this is an excellent primer for those.
