Total Cash All Bank accounts \$265,405.98

Main Club has \$152K available

Dupree account total value is \$233,938.52

LPL Financial total value is \$6,205.31. The initial investment was \$5,875.00 on July 6, 2022.

Total YTD loss for Operations (Main Club, Farm and GP Range) is \$54,921.95.

Main Club shows a net profit of \$13,246.64, the Farm and GP show losses of \$15,858.66 and \$52,309.93 respectively. The YTD loss is the result of the approximately \$62,000.00 loss in bond value.

Net Income before for depreciation, capital expenditures and bond loss is \$87,259.54.

Total Operations YTD gross income is \$421,561.42. This is \$9,382.25 above the FY21-22 YTD budget, mostly due to the second sale of cattle.

Total Membership Income is \$346,092.14. This is \$8,657.86 below the FY21-22 budget amount.

Total YTD expenses are \$52,437.47 below FY21-22 budget.

FY21-22 Operations loss is \$5,486.38 below the YTD FY21-22 budgeted loss of \$60,408.337.

For the Fiscal Year to date, Pistol, Shotgun, Archery, Casting and Muzzleloader Divisions had losses while Rifle and Gun Dog Divisions had profits. Pistol has spent \$57,402.36 on Facility Improvements. Shotgun has made \$48,250.98 in Facility Improvements funded mostly by \$39,557.00 in donations.

Expenses \$967,932.56 (\$62,032.10 in bond fund losses)

Net Loss -\$104,381.69

There is \$120,316.94 in Capital Expenditures that will be moved to Assets at Fiscal Year-end which changes the Net Loss to a Net Profit of \$15,935.25.
