

BGSL in May 2023

Spring will be in full swing at the Blue Grass Sportsmen's League this month, so how will you get out and enjoy your club every chance you get with family and friends? Other Items of Interest Driving on Handys Bend to BGSL

Please use caution and be considerate of residents and other users of Handys Bend: there have been concerns received from people living on Handys Bend, some of them fellow members, about vehicles travelling at excessive speeds to the club, with some indicating that their tolerance for the problem is growing thin. Given the high shoulders and the narrowness of the road, these concerns are valid, and if we do not take responsibility for our driving, there will almost certainly be repercussions in terms of potentially more accidents and almost certainly more speeding tickets. Considering that Handys Bend is our only means of access and that a good relationship with the neighborhood is vastly preferable to the alternative, spending one or two extra minutes to get to the club is not a lot to ask.

Check Calendar for Rifle Range Regularly

At this time, the 300 Yard Rifle Range is regularly open to both centerfire and rimfire shooters under the Revised 300 Yard Rifle Range Policy typically in the afternoon Wednesdays through Saturdays, with occasional adjustments applied to compensate for match usage that conflicts with the typical schedule. We will continue to publish the schedule for these uses one week at a time on the BGSL Website Events Calendar, so please get into the habit of checking the calendar

regularly if you want to use the 300 Yard Range and are properly certified. Meanwhile, GP is open all day every day as always, including the use of centerfires.

Storm Cleanup
