Operations / Farm Report – by Ben Riffell

- Settlement of \$200,000 was received for the 2 barns that were destroyed during the storm.
- The barn at the front gate was insured for \$50 and the other \$150K.
- The workshop roof will be on a separate claim.
- Insurance premium of \$2000 that was saved from barns that were eliminated as well as the monies from the damaged barns were placed in a designated account.
- The plan is for a new shop and hoop barn to be installed. Cost associated is being reviewed.
- The club had to wait for an insurance settlement before cleanup of barns.
- Divisions can make use of salvaged lumber.
- Once the divisions have their portion, the members will be notified of opportunity to salvage any remaining materials.
- Have received a couple of bids on shop roof, which is currently handled by a separate claim.
- Turkey Season is open for one more week. Currently 4 birds have been harvested.
- Dove fields have been planted and sprayed.

- 10 feeder calves have been sold, averaging approx. \$1,100 a head.
- Bathhouse opened for summer.
- The fishing pond has been stocked. 2 catfish per member, per day.
- Boater Education class is scheduled for May 27th.
