BGSL Dues Effective August 7, 2023

The third of four 5% annual "cost of living" increases approved by the membership in July of 2020 will take effect on August 7. These increases affect members a year from their last annual renewal (regardless of payment period). The rates for 2023-2024 are:

- Annual \$335(Cash or Check)/\$345.05(Credit Card)
- Semi-annual \$174.20
- Quarterly \$87.10
- Monthly \$29.00
- Life \$5695 (17x Annual, by cash or check)
