#### Treasurer Report: by Ron Summers

Total Cash All Bank accounts \$603,536.14 Dupree account total value is \$218,342.62 LPL Financial total value is \$20,288.35 Main Club account\$235,000

All amounts listed in this section have the \$200,000.00 of insurance proceeds deducted from the amounts shown in the P&L Operations Report.

Net Operating Income for Operations (Main Club, Farm and GP Range) is \$37,088.49. This is \$86,921.82 above the predicted YTD budget loss of \$49,833.33.

Net Operating Income before Depreciation and Capital Expenditures is \$93,191.03. Main Club shows a Net Operating Income of \$105,086.52, the Farm and GP show losses of \$29,023.32 and \$38,974.71 respectively.

Total Operations gross income is \$385,337.94. This is \$14,004.61 above the FY22-23 budget. Total Membership Income is \$326,090.69. This is \$6,090.69 above the FY22-23 budget amount. Membership renewal income is \$50,872.57 below YTD budget. This shortfall is offset by new membership income of \$49,243.26 and Corporate Memberships of \$7,720.00 (Total of \$56,963.26).

Total expenses are \$74,882.19 below YTD budget.

FY22-23 Net Income is \$86,921.82 better than the projected YTD budget loss of \$49,833.33. For the Fiscal Year to Date, Gun Dog, Muzzleloader, Pistol, and Rifle have reported profits while Archery, Casting and Shotgun have reported losses.
