At this time, the 300 Yard Rifle Range is regularly open to both centerfire and rimfire shooters under the Revised 300 Yard Rifle Range Policy typically in the afternoon Wednesdays through Saturdays, with occasional adjustments applied to compensate for match usage that conflicts with the typical schedule. We will continue to publish the schedule for these uses one week at a time on the BGSL Website Events Calendar, so please get into the habit of checking the calendar regularly if you want to use the 300 Yard Range and are properly certified. Meanwhile, GP is open all day every day as always, including the use of centerfires.

Construction Projects on the Property

The new shop building is going up now in the same location as the old hay barn (near the "Y"). Construction started on November 27th and the exterior of the structure is expected to be complete within 2 weeks of the start date.

Also, construction of baffles at the 300Y rifle range will start Monday, December 4th, and the positions of posts for supporting the baffles have already been marked. The construction of the baffles is not expected to disrupt the normal rifle range hours (Wednesday through Saturday) for next week, but any closures that arise because of it will, of course, be noted on the calendar.

Current Hunting Seasons and Member Safety Precautions

Modern Deer Season is over, but Archery season is still open and there will be a Muzzleloader season in December. The second and third late Dove seasons are also open for part of December. Please be aware that these activities are going on, and exercise both caution and consideration when you intend to go into areas that are used for hunting or areas around the dove field. Remember to check the map of hunter check ins in the entry hall of the clubhouse before going any place other than the division main areas, ranges and pits. If a hunter is present in the area you intend to go, select another area. If the area of the map is clear, it is safe for you to proceed, but you should place a marker with your contact information and activity on the board and remove it before leaving the club.

Hiking Trails

The Palisades Overlook Trail (yellow markers -- 1 mile), VanMeter Trail (blue markers -- 1 mile), and the newer Meadow Trail (orange markers -- ~1.5 miles, but very gentle terrain) are freshly marked and have been gone through recently. If you like a challenge, try the River Trail. Be extra cautious and considerate on the trails during hunting season (see section above), especially mornings and evenings when hunters are most active, and it never hurts to wear bright colors or even orange when in the

woods.

New Member Orientations

There are meeting times on the calendar for Orientations, but in order to keep the group sizes low, additional orientation meetings may be needed. New members should arrange for a meeting time directly with the office (859-858-4060) rather than simply coming to one of the pre-scheduled meeting times.

Pit Pass Qualifier

One of these at a minimum will be offered every month, typically on the 3rd Saturday of each month. Like the new member orientations, the qualifiers must be organized to limit numbers, so let Ben Riffell know that you are interested by contacting him or leaving a
