



Temporary Range Use Policy

In our continuing efforts to eliminate any rounds from potentially leaving the boundaries of BGSL and in an abundance of caution regarding any potential risk to public safety, the Blue Grass Sportsmen's League Board of Officers and Directors has adopted a **temporary policy of restricted, conditional uses for the 300 Yard Rifle Range and Pistol Pit 4**. The General Purpose Range remains open, subject to existing range specific rules and policy restrictions. This Temporary Range Use Policy is appended below. While the policy has been formally adopted, as of September 20th, it may take some time to implement its requirements, but these ranges will be reopened ***under the new restrictions*** as quickly as is practical. Meantime, the status of the the 300 Yard Rifle Range and Pistol Pit 4 will be updated as required on the [BGSL Website Events Calendar](#).

Temporary Range Use Policy 300 Yard Rifle Range and Pistol Pit 4

300 Yard Rifle Range

- Only .22 long rifle with a muzzle velocity of less than 1,200 feet per second will be permitted.
- No rounds will be chambered in a rifle without having acquisition of the target through the sighting system of the rifle.
- Shooting will only be permitted at a sanctioned event under the supervision of a qualified individual (match director, NRA/USPSA/IDPA certified range officer) or during specified operational hours of the General Purpose Range with the supervision of a qualified individual (match director, NRA/USPSA/IDPA certified range officer).
- All shooters using the range outside of a sanctioned event must possess a BGSL Advanced Rifle Certification.
- Any additional events outside of the scope of these restrictions will be reviewed for approval by an appointed committee.

Pistol Pit 4

- Only straight wall, non-magnum handgun cartridges, .22 long rifle with a muzzle velocity of less than 1,300 feet per second, or multi-projectile shotgun shells with a muzzle velocity of less

than 1,300 feet per second.

- Shooting will only be permitted at a sanctioned event under the supervision of a qualified individual (match director, NRA/USPSA/IDPA certified range officer) or during specified operational hours of the General Purpose Range with the supervision of a qualified individual (match director, NRA/USPSA/IDPA certified range officer).
- All shooters using the range outside of a sanctioned event must possess a BGSL Red Pit Pass.
- Any additional events outside of the scope of these restrictions will be reviewed for approval by an appointed committee.
