Check Calendar for Rifle Range Regularly

At this time, the 300 Yard Rifle Range is regularly open to both centerfire and rimfire shooters under the Revised 300 Yard Rifle Range Policy typically in the afternoon Wednesdays through Saturdays, with occasional adjustments applied to compensate for match usage that conflicts with the typical schedule. We will continue to publish the schedule for these uses one week at a time on the BGSL Website Events Calendar, so please get into the habit of checking the calendar regularly if you want to use the 300 Yard Range and are properly certified. Meanwhile, GP is open all day every day as always, including the use of centerfires.

Construction Projects on the Property

The new shop building is going up now in the same location as the old hay barn (near the "Y"). The exterior of the structure is nearly complete, further work will be completed after concrete work. Prep work for concrete is complete and the pouring and finish work is expected to start the first week of the year.

Also, construction of baffles on the 300Y rifle range is structurally complete, and though some minor modifications and improvements may still be in the works, they are not

expected to interfere with the current Wednesday to Saturday hours for the range.

Current Hunting Seasons and Member Safety Precautions

There is less hunting going on in January than previous months, but there will still be some activity. Please be aware that these activities are going on, and exercise both caution and consideration when you intend to go into areas that are used for hunting. Remember to check the map of hunter check ins in the entry hall of the clubhouse before going any place other than the division main areas, ranges and pits. If a hunter is present in the area you intend to go, select another area. If the area of the map is clear, it is safe for you to proceed, but you should place a marker with your contact information and activity on the board and remove it before leaving the club.

Hiking Trails

Be extra cautious and considerate on the trails during hunting season (see section above), especially mornings and evenings when hunters are most active, and it never hurts to wear bright colors or even orange when in the woods.
