The next General Membership Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 2, at 7PM. Those of you who have been attending the General Meetings for the last several years know that our resident Chef, Jeff Spry, has really taken the food for these meetings to the next level. Other Items of Interest Reminder of 300 Yard Rifle Range Expanded Availability

As of last month, the BOD expanded Rifle Range hours to be the same as GP Range Hours. Shooters must be members in good standing, have a current advanced rifle certification, sign-in/out at the GP Range, and obey all <u>range rules</u> & safety expectations. Please note that prone shooting is allowed, but only during sanctioned events under a qualified Match Director or during times at which an RSO is physically present on the 300 Yard Range.

Spring Turkey Lottery -- Tickets Available Soon
General Spring Turkey Season this year runs from April 13th to May 5th. Tickets
for the Spring Turkey Lottery at BGSL were available starting at the March General
Membership Meeting and will be available through most of the April General

Membership Meeting (2 April) at which point the drawing will be held. You may also purchase tickets by phone by calling the office (859-858-4060, M-F/9a-5p). You do not have to be present at the drawing to be eligible, but you do need to buy a ticket or tickets to have a chance at winning. Tickets are \$10 each or 10 for \$80. Only ten spots are available, and BGSL is a great place to hunt turkeys, so don't miss your chance.

Front Gate

The March BOD voted to activate all members' gate cards for 24 hour access. This means that soon, your gate card will allow you to enter 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, so if you need before- or after-hours access, dig out your old gate card! For most people, however, the change should not be noticeable, as the gate will be open (no card required) from approximately 8am to whenever the last sanctioned event is over on the property, just as is being done currently. Please note that once the 24 hour access is activated that cards will open the gate and close behind you if used before normal opening or after normal closing time, so if you are running an event that requires access to others without gate cards before or after regular hours, you will need to obtain a code from the office to hold the gate open, and, if after hours, you will be responsible for closing the gate when it is no longer required to be open. Likewise, if you need access outside of normal hours for some reason before the gate card changes are made, please contact the office for a code that will allow that.

Shop Building at Y

The shop building is progressing, and the interior wall and insulation in the shop area are complete or nearly so. Some work remains on the exterior of the shed and drain field, along with the interior wiring, lighting, plumbing, and finish/furnishing.

Steel targets are used to help build your confidence, reinforce your positive shooting experience, and keep down time to a minimum. This is not a beginner level class. Attendees should be experienced in the safe handling of a handgun to include drawing from a holster safely and reloading it from a magazine pouch.
