

BGSL in May 2024

Like every year, May at the Blue Grass Sportsmen's League is "off to the races": It is always one of the busiest months of the year in general for every one, starting with the Derby and ending with the Memorial Day weekend, with all sorts of events scheduled in between to take advantage of the great weather. There are plenty of events scheduled at BGSL for May as well, but not so many that you won't be able to find a place to enjoy yourself in relative solitude if that is what you want. Take full advantage of May weather and your favorite activities and your club's 1500 acres of outdoors to put yourself in the winner's circle.

General Membership Meeting

The next General Membership Meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 7, at 7PM. Come on down to your club and find out what is going on, ask questions of the officers, voice your opinions or concerns, or simply fellowship with other members over the meal following the meeting. For those who have not attended a General Meeting in years, the quality of the food prepared by BGSL's Jeff Spry excels across a wide variety of fare from simple to elegant, making attendance mandatory for those who enjoy good food to go along with good company.

Other Items of Interest 300 Yard Rifle Range Expanded Availability

The BOD expanded Rifle Range hours to be the same as GP Range Hours in March, and now there are expanded hours (dawn to dusk) available to Advanced Rifle Certificate holders, thanks to the installation of baffles and security cameras: Ask the RSO at GP for details. Shooters must be members in good standing, have a current advanced rifle certification, sign-in/out at the GP Range, and obey all range rules & safety expectations. Please note that prone shooting is allowed, but only during sanctioned events under a qualified Match Director or during times at which an RSO is physically present on the 300 Yard Range.

Spring Turkey Hunting

The spring Turkey Season is almost complete (ends May 5). So far, at least 7 Turkeys have been harvested, one of which was by a youth hunter, and the Turkey was one of

those which the state tagged, and it was eligible for a cash prize.

Dove Field

The Dove Field preparation is under way currently, pending weather, of course. There will be one field for the 2024 season, located to the right of the road from the "T" to the "new" fishing pond.

Bath House Open/Getting New Roof

With the danger of frost past, the Bath House has been re-opened for member use. It is slated for a new roof very soon if not already underway, but should remain open during the process. Just be aware that it may be going on when you use the bath house.

Front Gate

Just a reminder that the March BOD voted to activate all members' gate cards for 24 hour access. This means that soon, your gate card will allow you to enter 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, so if you need before- or after-hours access, dig out your old gate card! For most people, however, the change should not be noticeable, as the gate will be open (no card required) from approximately 8am to whenever the last sanctioned event is over on the property, just as is being done currently. Please note that once the 24 hour access is activated that cards will open the gate and close behind you if used before normal opening or after normal closing time, so if you are running an event that requires access to others without gate cards before or after regular hours, you will need to obtain a code from the office to hold the gate open, and, if after hours, you will be responsible for closing the gate when it is no longer required to be open. Likewise, if you need access outside of normal hours for some reason before the gate card changes are made, please contact the office for a code that will allow that.

Shop Building at Y

The shop building's interior wall and insulation in the shop area is complete, and the electrical service is installed. Some minor work remains on the exterior of the shed, grading the area around the shop, and installing the septic field, along with the interior wiring, lighting, plumbing, and finish/furnishing.

Be extra cautious and considerate on the trails during hunting seasons, especially mornings and evenings when hunters are most active, and it never hurts to wear bright colors or even orange when in the woods. Brian has a full Carbine Series scheduled for 2024, starting with an intro class on May 4 and progressing to a Begginers' class in June, followed by several Intermediate Carbine classes through the summer into the Fall.

<u>Natalie Bohon</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.): Natalie continues to be available for private or small group lessons, and she will be available more on the weekends than she has been in the past.

Mark Sands has three classes scheduled for 2024 at BGSL: March 17(completed), July 14, and September 29. All classes are from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. Six individual drills will introduce you to a variety of different shooting exercises that will help develop your tactical handgun skills. Steel targets are used to help build your confidence, reinforce your positive shooting experience, and keep down time to a minimum. This is not a beginner level class. Attendees should be experienced in the safe handling of a handgun to include drawing from a holster safely and reloading it from a magazine pouch.
