300 Yard Rifle Range

The 300 yard Rifle Range is operating during normal hours of operations with the option of dawn to dusk for advanced rifle certificate holders and properly certified guest(s). Ask an RSO at GP if you need additional information about use of the 300 yard rifle range. Approved steel targets have been installed and may be used by any qualified member, but member-supplied steel targets are not allowed.

General Safety Guidelines during Hunting Seasons (currently Dove and Deer)

Dove Hunting and Archery Deer Season are in full swing, and there will be a Youth Only
Firearms Weekend the second weekend in October, as well as an early Muzzle loader
season the following weekend. If you are not hunting, please be aware of the fact
that others may be, and check the hunters' map at the clubhouse if you intend to
go outside the established range areas or any place near hunting areas. You
should consider putting up a marker on the map for yourself before going afield
(and taking it down before you leave the property) to alert others of your
presence.

Mark Sands has three classes scheduled for 2024 at BGSL: March 17(past), July 14(past), and Sunday, October 20. All classes are from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. Six individual drills will introduce you to a variety of different shooting exercises that will help develop your tactical handgun skills. Steel targets are used to help build your confidence, reinforce your positive shooting experience, and keep down time to a minimum. This is not a beginner level class. Attendees should be experienced in the safe handling of a handgun to include drawing from a holster safely and reloading it from a magazine pouch.
