300 Yard Rifle Range

The 300 yard Rifle Range is operating during normal hours of operations with the option of dawn to dusk for advanced rifle certificate holders and properly certified guest(s). Ask an RSO at GP if you need additional information about use of the 300 yard rifle range. Approved steel targets have been installed and may be used by any qualified member, but member-supplied steel targets are not allowed.

Front Gate

Gate cards are working in general, allowing members 24 hour access, although the gate will remain open during the day as usual. A limited number of existing cards have problems, but we are working to resolve those issues as we become aware of them. Current Hunting Seasons and Member Safety Precautions

Modern Deer Season is over, but Archery season is still open and there will be a Muzzleloader season in December. The second and third late Dove seasons are also open for part of December. Please be aware that these activities are going on, and exercise both caution and consideration when you intend to go into areas that are used for hunting or areas around the dove field. Remember to check the map of hunter check ins in the entry hall of the clubhouse before going any place other than the division main areas, ranges and pits. If a hunter is present in the area you intend to go, select another area. If the area of the map is clear, it is safe for you to proceed, but you should place a marker with your contact information and activity on the board and remove it before leaving the club.

CWD Sample Drop-Off Site at BGSL

Kentucky Fish and Wildlife has added BGSL as a CWD Sample Drop-Off Site. There is a freezer designated for this use in the pavilion of the main clubhouse. See the link in header for other sites and details about submitting samples. Given the potential threat of Chronic Wasting Disease to deer in Kentucky, we are happy to participate in the program.

Be extra cautious and considerate on the trails during hunting season (see section above), especially mornings and evenings when hunters are most active, and it never hurts to wear bright colors or even orange when in the woods.

NOTE: The instructors listed in this section are all BGSL members and are certified by the BGSL Training Committee.

<u>Natalie Bohon</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.): Natalie continues to be available for private or small group lessons, and she will be available more on the weekends than she has been in the past.

<u>Timothy Johnson</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.) focuses primarily on the basics of pistol shooting in small group classes, but he is also available for private individual lessons and coaching. Contact him via the button on his instructor profile page.

<u>Brian King/PRS Training Solutions</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.) offers a wide range of opportunities to train in pistol, rifle and shotgun through classes or private lessons. Brian taught the last Intermediate Carbine class planned for this year in October, but he is still available for private instruction.

Mark Sands Mark typically schedules 3 or 4 classes at BGSL during the warmer months (spring-fall), and all of his 2024 classes are complete. All classes are from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. Six individual drills will introduce you to a variety of different shooting exercises that will help develop your tactical handgun skills. Steel targets are used to help build your confidence, reinforce your positive shooting experience, and keep down time to a minimum. This is not a beginner level class. Attendees should be experienced in the safe handling of a handgun to include drawing from a holster safely and reloading it from a magazine pouch. Yes, the price has increased, but each membership will receive two passes at no charge at renewal time, and two reduced rate passes are available to members each year (see the linked BLAST for details on your free and reduced rate guest passes). Also, remember that the family membership policy is generally very open to people living in the main members' household and that minors in general (including grandchildren) may be mentored without a guest fee, so call the office if you need specific detail on whether you need to buy a guest pass for someone if you think they may be excepted.

Rimfire Precision Rifle Series (formerly NRL22)

The NRL22 program started 3 years ago has switched over to the Rimfire Precision Rifle Series in recent months to cater to local demand. The basic idea is still the same, take a 22LR and clang steel targets at various distances from multiple shooting positions while under a time limit. Each month we set up 8 different stages, each one requiring 8-12 shots in 1 min and 45 seconds. Scoring is straight forward, either you hit the designated target(s) or you don't. While we have some targets out to 290 yards, the majority of the targets are under 150.

The start of each match competitors have 45-60 min to verify their 50 yard zero on paper and calibrate their ballistic solving app/device on steel targets at various distances. Sound interesting? All you need to get started is a mag fed 22LR bolt or semi auto riflewith a scope that has adjustable target turrets, ammo you can shoot 1-2 moa with, at least 2 10 round magazines, a bipod, and a support sandbag. Spectators are always welcome during matches and usually find them selves trying out a few shots on a stage.

Our next match is scheduled for Sunday, December 15.
