Other Items of Interest

Time Change and Holiday Hours Reminder

EST starts back on Nov. 3, so check the operating hours <u>here</u>. Likewise, holiday hours will be posted there as they become determined, and the website calendar will be updated as appropriate at the same time.

300 Yard Rifle Range

The 300 yard Rifle Range is operating during normal hours of operations with the option of dawn to dusk for advanced rifle certificate holders and properly certified guest(s). Ask an RSO at GP if you need additional information about use of the 300 yard rifle range. Approved steel targets have been installed and may be used by any qualified member, but member-supplied steel targets are not allowed.

Current Hunting Seasons and Member Safety Precautions

There will be several hunting seasons, including modern firearms for deer, in full swing in November (or parts of it), so please be aware that these activities are going on, and exercise both caution and consideration when you intend to go into areas that are used

for hunting or areas near the dove field when in use. Remember to check the map of hunter check ins in the entry hall of the clubhouse before going any place other than the division main areas, ranges and pits. If a hunter is present in the area you intend to go, select another area. If the area of the map is clear, it is safe for you to proceed, but you should place a marker with your contact information and activity on the board and remove it before leaving the club.

Hiking Trails

Be extra cautious and considerate on the trails during hunting season (see section above), and it never hurts to wear bright colors or even orange when in the woods.

Camping at BGSL

Fishing

With the generally cooling (but not cold!) weather, action may pick up at the fishing pond. Remember that the limit is two catfish per membership each day; all other species are catch and release only.

<u>Brian King/PRS Training Solutions</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.) offers a wide range of opportunities to train in pistol, rifle and shotgun through classes or private lessons. Brian taught the last Intermediate Carbine class planned for this year in October, but he is still available for private instruction.

<u>Natalie Bohon</u> (link to instructor page with contact information, etc.): Natalie continues to be available for private or small group lessons, and she will be available more on the weekends than she has been in the past.

Mark Sands Mark typically schedules 3 or 4 classes at BGSL during the warmer months (spring-fall), and all of his 2024 classes are complete. All classes are from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. Six individual drills will introduce you to a variety of different shooting exercises that will help develop your tactical handgun skills. Steel targets are used to help build your confidence, reinforce your positive shooting experience, and keep down time to a minimum. This is not a beginner level class. Attendees should be experienced in the safe handling of a handgun to include drawing from a holster safely and reloading it from a magazine pouch. Pit Pass Qualifier

One of these at a minimum will be offered every month, typically on the 3rd Saturday of each month. Guest Passes
