



After-Dark/Low-Light Shooting Policy Update for Pits and GP

In response to requests by members for clarification on after-dark/low-light shooting opportunities on club ranges, BGSL Operations instituted a pilot program, and the Board of Officers and Directors has approved the resulting policy below.

Dark/Low-Light Shooting Policy

Only the pistol pits and the baffled general purpose range are under consideration for "after dark/ low-light" shooting scenarios:

- 1 Participating shooters(s) must be a member in good standing with a valid red pit pass (pits) or an advanced rifle "pink card" (GP baffled range); All additional Pit and GP Range rules are enforced.
 - 2 Member MUST fully sign-in & out at the GP range in the after hours range logbook.
 - 3 Shooter must have another person (participating or not) present during all dark/low light shooting activities.
 - 4 Member shall observe an end time of NO LATER than 10pm.
 - 5 Member shooter(s) will advise operations via text upon arrival/departure from range during dark/low-light.
 - 6 Previously scheduled events always take priority.
 - 7 Shooting suppressed is encouraged; use of pistol pit #3 in low-light scenarios is encouraged.
