## A Note on the use of 50 yard targets at Advanced Rifle

For those who are certified for Advanced Rifle and want to practice the 50Y targets such as used for ABRA on the 300Y Rifle Range, we will be leaving a couple of 50 yard target stands set up for your convenience.

## Prone positions for 300Y Range

A baffle system to support prone shooting by qualified members without RSO supervision is in place on a couple of lanes pending some final tweaks. If these interest you, ask the RSO at GP about proper use of the baffles before you use them for the

#### **New Member Orientations**

There are meeting times on the calendar for Orientations, but in order to keep the group sizes low, additional orientation meetings may be needed. New members should arrange for a meeting time directly with the office (859-858-4060) rather than simply coming to one of the pre-scheduled meeting times.

#### **Pit Pass Qualifier**

One of these at a minimum will be offered every month, typically on the 3rd Saturday of each month. Like the new member orientations, the qualifiers must be organized to limit numbers, so let Ben Riffell know that you are interested by contacting him or leaving a message for him at the office at 859-858-4060, and he can notify you when a space in the qualifier is available.

#### **Guest Passes**

For members' reference, here, again, is a link to a copy of the **BLAST** email regarding guest passes. Most feedback so far has focused on the price increase last summer but ignored several mitigating factors. Each membership will receive two passes at no charge at renewal time, and two reduced rate passes are available to members each year (see the linked BLAST for details on your free and reduced rate guest passes). Also, remember that the family membership policy is generally very open to people living in the main member's household and that minors in general (including grandchildren) may be mentored without a guest fee, so call the office if you need specific detail on whether you need to buy a guest pass for someone if you think they may be an excepted case. In addition, many activities do not require a guest fee at all, such as hiking, camping, or simply showing someone around the club, not to mention that Shotgun is open to the public during normal operating hours, so no guest fee is required to take someone there, either. Finally, if anyone wants to conduct a regular, structured program of recruitment, we are potentially willing to waive the guest fee, if required, in such situations, so contact the office or one of the club officers to discuss that possibility.
