 - A pair of Angus bulls were delivered. Calves expected in March
 - The annual pond stocking of fish was delivered on May 27th.
 - The FCPS called the club to inquire about the use of our facility for training and qualification for their school resource officers.
 - KU Corporation recently joined
 - Under the First Responder/Military, Veteran Policy – 4 First Responders, and 4 Military have joined. And 4 within the 90-day trial period.
